Attendance Celebration and Easter Eggs

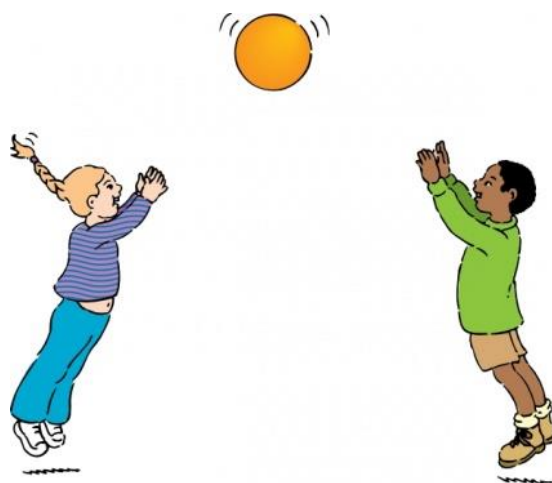
