Fond Farewells

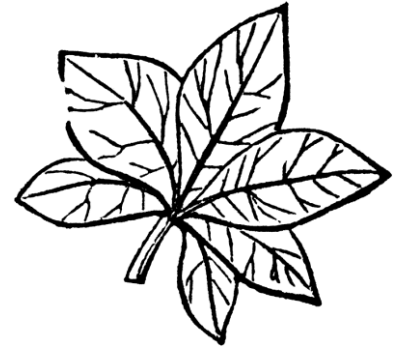
