Parking Partnership with PCSOs & Safety

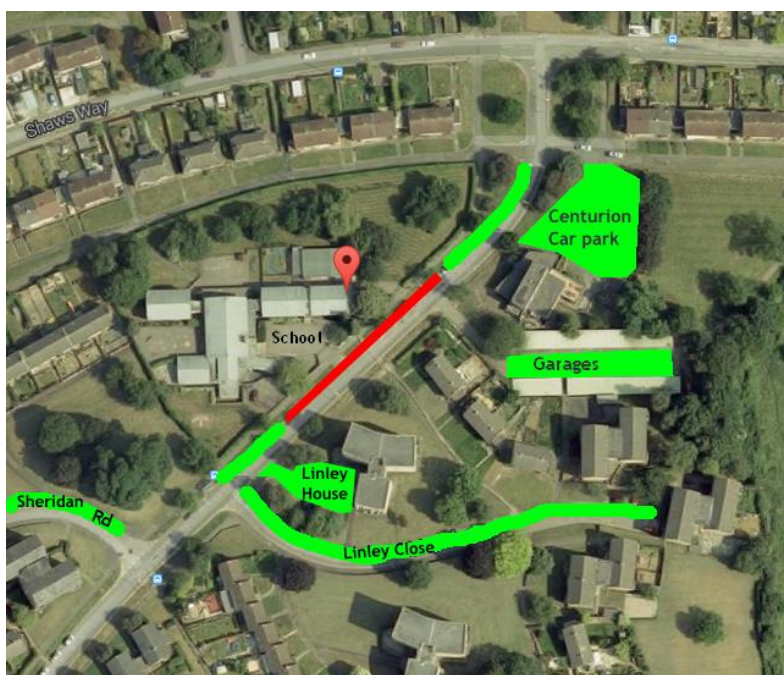
A number of parents have recently reported concerns about cars parked on the yellow lines immediately outside of school. When this happens it becomes much more dangerous to cross the road.

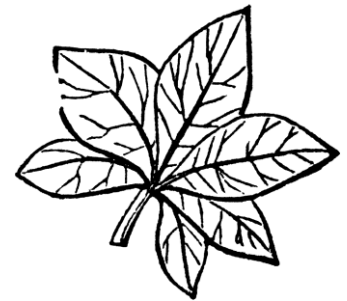

- **Taylor** – for trying really hard with his writing.

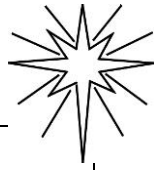
