

Scarlet Fever Alert

We have had one confirmed case of Scarlet Fever in the school. The initial symptoms usually include a **sore throat**, **headache** and a **high temperature** (38.3C/101F or above), **flushed cheeks** and a **swollen tongue**. A day or two later the characteristic pinkish rash appears. It usually occurs on the chest and stomach before spreading to other areas of the body, such as the ears and neck.



Scarlet fever usually clears up after about a week, but if you think you or your child may have it, see your GP for a proper diagnosis and appropriate treatment. You can find out more about the illness here:
