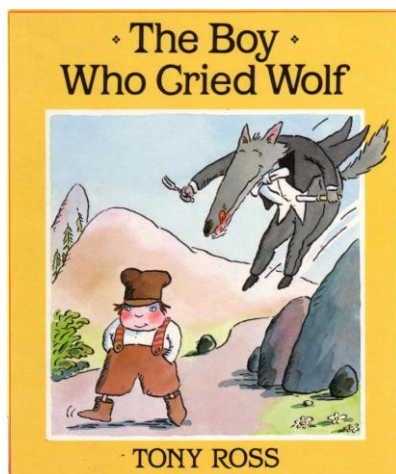

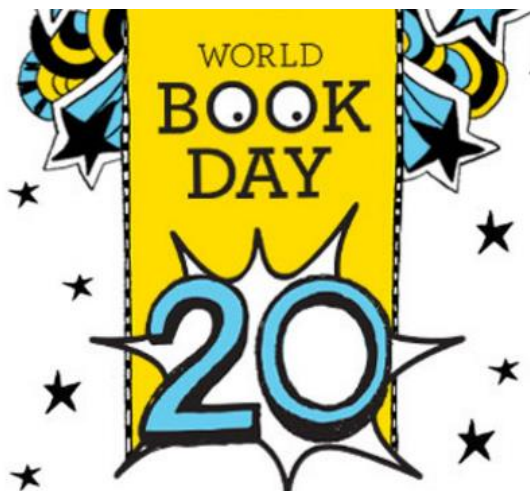

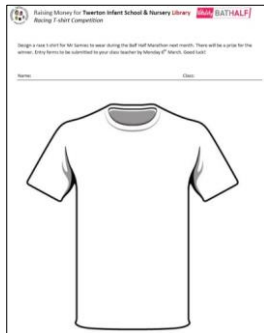
1) Sponsorship Competition
