Parliamentary Candidate Visits



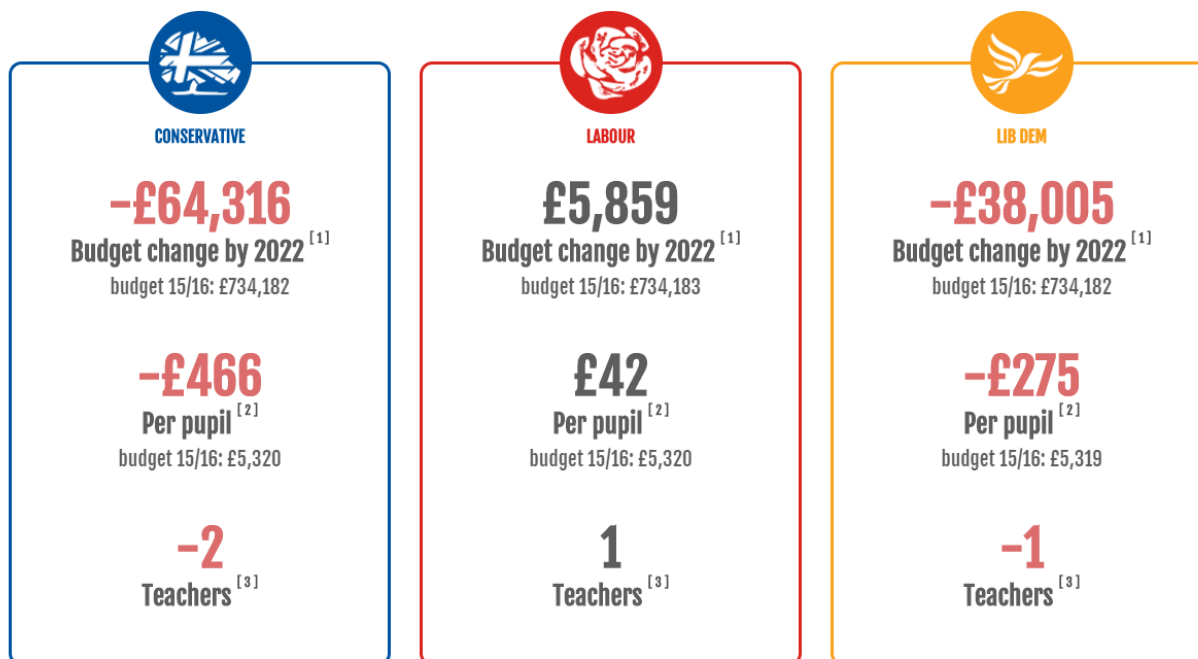
Last week we had a visit from **Ben Howlett** (Conservative) accompanied by George Freeman.
