## **Class Photos on Friday 7<sup>th</sup> June**

The school photographer is in school on Friday 7<sup>th</sup> June to take class photographs. **This is a change of date the previously published date. Please ensure your child is in school uniform.**

## Change to morning drop off

When we return tomorrow the school will open, as usual, at **8:45am**. External doors and gates will remain open for 10 minutes and at **8:55am** the gate on Shaws Way and all the external white doors will then be closed.



**After 8:55am, the only entry to the school will be through the main entrance.** Children arriving after 9:05am will be recorded as late.

We are doing this as we want to encourage all children to arrive by 8:55am and ideally at 8:45am. The time at the start of the morning is really important for changing reading books, practising handwriting, spellings and number facts. If your child arrives late they are missing out on vital learning time, which adds up to about 1 whole week of school by the end of the year!

## Keeping Safe in Warmer Weather



As the weather becomes warmer, especially on sunny days, please do remember to apply **sun-screen** to your child's face and neck in the morning. Also, please provide your child with a **hat** and a **water bottle**.

At lunchtimes, we will ensure the children have access to shade and we will utilise the wooded area at the bottom of the school site for play. Also, we will make sure children have access to their water bottles during play times (*names on bottles is really helpful*). Thank you for your help with this.

## End of Day Collection

If you are not able to collect your child at the end of the school day, please make sure your child's teacher knows who will be collecting them and ensure that your consent is given by signing in the class Collection Book unless the person is already listed on our system as a family contact.

If your child's collection arrangements change during the course of the day please telephone or send an SMS to the school office to let us know who will be picking up your child and do so by **2:45pm** at the latest.
